

ROLAND HEMOND 1929 – 2021



Honorary Hoop Historian Roland Hemond passed away at the age of 92. Roland was a 2018 inductee of the Hoop Historians. Hemond was twice named Major League Baseball Executive of the Year and became the second person to receive the Buck O'Neil Lifetime Achievement Award, presented by the Baseball Hall of Fame. The award recognizes individual who enhances baseball's positive image on society, broadens the game's appeal and whose integrity and dignity are comparable to the namesake of the award: Buck O'Neil, who will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame later this year. Hemond was the guest speaker at the Hoop Historians 2017 Welcome Dinner in Phoenix, Arizona.
