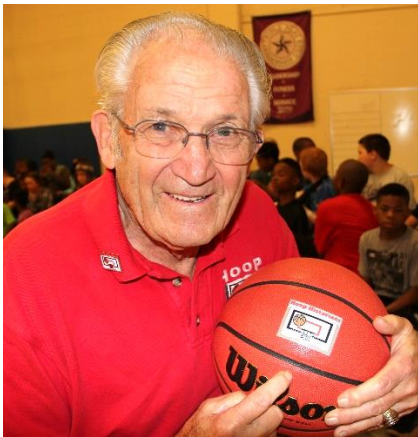


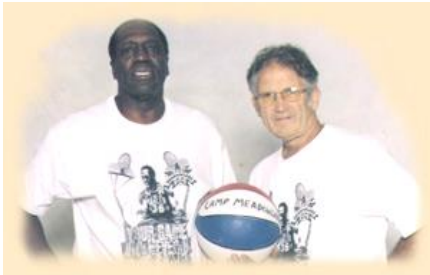


COACH JOHN MAYBERRY 1932-2023

Mayberry always took time to stop and smell the flowers



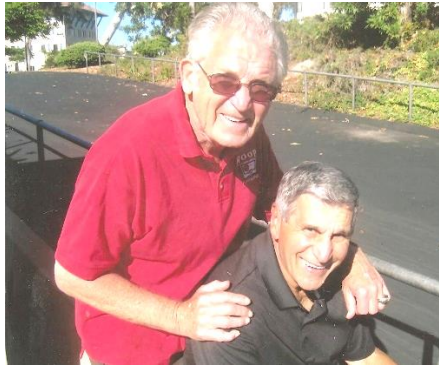
Mayberry was recognized for his outstanding disposable camera photography expertise
