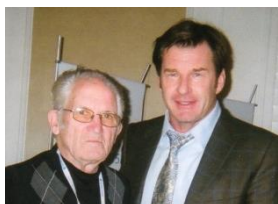


HOOP HISTORIANS SOCIAL EVENT TO INCLUDE AWARDS PROGRAM

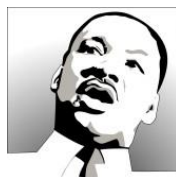
